EXAMINATION ARRANGEMENTS: TERM 4

Pupils in Grades Eight to Eleven write full-scale examinations in the fourth term. The exams will start on Monday, 28 October and will end on 22 November. Most of the Grade 11 exam papers are external (provincial) examinations.

During the examinations school will commence at 07:40 as usual and pupils will be released from school at 12:00. Pupils must be at school every day whether they write an examination on that day or not. Should you, however, decide to keep your son/daughter at home on a day that he/she is not writing an examination, then you are requested to confirm this in writing. This 'permission to study at home' letter can include all the study days and must be given to your child's class teacher. Parents are requested to ensure that their children give their full support in respect of the examination arrangements.

We request that parents do not make morning appointments for their children during the examinations. Should your child miss an examination for medical reasons a certified doctor's certificate must be supplied. This certificate must indicate that the doctor examined the child, must state what the child is/was suffering from and must confirm that the child was unfit to attend school on that particular day. If a doctor's certificate is not supplied then your child will get zero for the examination missed.

Regrettably we have found in the past that there are isolated cases of pupils involving themselves in examination irregularities, assisting another pupil or other forms of dishonesty. Pupils must ensure that they do not compromise their position in any way as far as honesty is concerned (including the use of a cell phone). As such, items like textbooks, notes, cell phones, or any other item that could be used to give examination assistance, must be stored away from the desk or table where the pupil is writing the examination. I wish to state quite clearly that the policy of this school is that, should a pupil be found to be dishonest in an examination or in breach of the above rules, that pupil will receive a mark of zero for the paper concerned as well as 9 demerits.

Textbooks will be collected each day. In order to prevent any unnecessary issues please remind your child to ensure their name is in all their textbooks. Lost or unreturned textbooks will incur an amount to be paid at the office. More information regarding collection of textbooks for 2025 will be communicated next term.

Thank you for your support. We hope these arrangements will assist the pupils in their preparation for the examinations.
